## DISCOUNTS

Early Payment Discount
Families choosing to pay tuition and ICT fees in total by the end of Term 1 (12 April 2024) will receive a $5 \%$ discount off the fees excluding diary.
Sibling Discount
We offer two types of sibling discount:

- Two daughters at OLSH:12.5\% discount from fees for each child Three or more daughters at OLSH: $15 \%$ discount from fees for each child
- For families who have children attending other Catholic Schools $3 \%$ remission from your eldest daughter's Tuition fees

OLSH offers families a number of ways to pay our fees. These are:

We offer a number of different payment plans including weekly, fortnightly, monthly and termly with further details included overleaf in the Payment Schedule section. Fees are due by the end of Term 1 each year or by the payment plan you have arranged with the school.

## MAKE AN APPOINTMENT

Please contact the Front Office to make a confidential appointment to see our Business Manager, to discuss a fee structure that may be more suitable to
your family's circumstances. We do not want the issue of fees to be a barrier to your daughter's education at OLSH. We are willing to assist you financially to achieve this goal.

## VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET) FEES

VET fees are in addition to school fees and families are responsible for payment to VET providers (not the College) prior to commencement of courses. VET courses are offered by external providers and fees are determined by the providers. Costs vary and details are available from our VET Co-ordinator. We offer a subsidy scheme through an application process. Successful applicants who meet eligibility requirements will receive a subsidy up to $\$ 200$ per student towards their course fees. This is payable after successful completion of the course.

Camps, Retreats and Excursions
These activities are all inclusive within the tuiton fee, and are not refundable if you choose not to attend.

Laptops, Carry Bags and Laptop Pens Each student is provided with an OLSH College laptop to use in her time here. The laptop must be cared for and an ICT levy is payable to cover the laptop, infrastructure and software used at the College. The laptop remains the property of OLSH College however students are required to pay $\$ 45$ for a laptop bag. It must be stored in the bag at all times and returned to the College on completion of your daughters education with us. All students must also purchase a laptop pen to use with the laptop to write on the screen, using with Apps etc for $\$ 50$.

## Stationery and Art Packs

Each year level have Stationery and Art Packs with information regarding these provided to families prior to the start of
each year including a supplier purchase option. All students in Year 7-10 receive a diary and the cost is $\$ 20$.

## Student ID Cards

A student ID Card is included in the school fees however there is a cost of $\$ 10$ for a replacement card if needed.

## Lockers

Lockers are provided to all students at no cost, however, the approved combination locks are only available from the College at a cost of $\$ 15$. This deposit is refundable when OLSH locks are returned in a satisfactory condition on completion of your daughter's education at OLSH College.

## Text Books

Text books are available through the Book Hire scheme and the "hire" fee is included in the tuition fee. Unreturned and damaged books will be charged to family accounts.

## School Care Insurance

The College provides a 24 hour cover for Students' Personal Accident and Disability (School Care) policy through insurance. Ambulance cover is included for any accidents that may occur. It does not cover any pre existing conditions. There is no charge to families for this cover.

## Student Printing

Students receive a printing credit dependent upon the year level of each student each term. The College has an ongoing vision to improve and develop technology along with environmental sustainability by reducing paper and using more online learning for sharing of work. Additional credits can be purchased from the Front Office if needed each term. Any unused credits will not carryover at the end of a term.

## ENROLMENT EXIT

When students leave school of their own volition, the family must provide a minimum of one Term's notice in writing addressed to the Principal of their decision to withdraw their daughter/s
