Essential scholarship information

- Instrumental or vocal Tuition fee remission (30 minute lessons) based on a maximum amount each term and instrumental hire if needed for 1 year
- Other incidental costs and additional lessons are not covered by the scholarship. The recipient must attend their weekly lesson, participate in relevant school ensembles and any associated performances
- Awarded to students currently undertaking or intending to undertake music tuition at OLSH
- Available to existing and new students starting at OLSH from any year level studying a particular instrument or voice
- A number of St Cecilia Instrumental Music Scholarships are awarded
- Tuition is available in many different instruments and scholarships may be awarded with regard to the number of students already learning this instrument
- Tuition is available in saxophone, clarinet, trumpet, voice, guitar and piano
- Students are not required to sit an instrumental or voice test or perform an audition in order to apply for this scholarship
