St Cecilia Instrumental Scholarship Application Form

Essential scholarship information

- The successful recipient will receive weekly instrumental or vocal tuition lessons (30 minutes) up to a maximum of 10 per term, and instrument hire if needed.
- The scholarship is for one year
- Other incidental costs and additional lessons are not covered by the scholarship
- The recipient must attend their weekly lesson, participate in relevant school ensembles and any associated performances
- This scholarship is available to existing and new students at OLSH College in 2027 from any year level who will study an instrument or voice
- Students currently undertaking or intending to undertake individual music tuition lessons are eligible to apply
- Tuition is available in many different instruments, and scholarships may be awarded with consideration to the number of students already learning that instrument.
- Tuition is available in woodwind, brass, guitar, piano and voice
- Students are not required to sit a test or perform an audition to apply for this scholarship
- A number of St Cecilia Instrumental Music Scholarships may be awarded
